

In a Pinery You Should Make Merry, While in a Birch Grove- Get Married

“Thank God, there are no such trees near them”, says Yevsei Meilitsev, vice president of the Russian Radio Esthesia Association. “It would be all right if they had no effect on people: however, they can be harmful”

“How can you, the father of the Russian doctrine of plants which favorably impact people, ascertain this? Do you think that the ancient druids knew less than you?”

“They probably knew a lot more than me about their forests, not ours. As a result of numerous experiments I discovered that the energies of two people born on the same day and at the same hour but in different climatic zones and continents are linked with different trees. I am also sure now that each human being has two trees, not just one, which are linked to his/her energy information exchange.

Yevsei Meilitsev’s interest in trees arose quite unexpectedly. Once when he had three teeth extracted, the pain was so acute that leaving the dentist and feeling so desperately weak he put his sore cheek against a tree. Suddenly he felt the pain subsiding. He stood there for several minutes. When the pain disappeared he looked up and saw that he was standing under a poplar.

At that time Meilitsev was an accomplished radio esthesist. His teacher, Nikolai Sachivanov, the founder of Russia’s modern radio esthesia school supported Meilitsev’s idea of investigating the impact of trees on human beings.

“I managed to define three types of trees’ impact on people and nature with the help of radioesthesia techniques using a metal frame. First, the energizing type which causes human energy to boost as a result of conduct with tree. Second, the type which causes energy to diminish. And third, the neutral one, which has no effect.

“Hence, the poplar absorbed the energy of my pain. I heal my chronic diseases with the help of a birch which energizes me. It gives me strength.”

Meilitsev studied the influence of almost all trees in the central region of Russia's European part. He went on expeditions to Ukraine and Belarus. He made several very important conclusions. Human beings are "tied" to the trees, minerals, stones and metals of their native land. It makes no difference whether you have light or dark skin, or are a Russian or Ethiopian. For example, the wife of Ethiopian journalist who was born in Madagascar gave birth to a daughter in Moscow six years ago. Oak trees give her energy, while asp trees absorb it. However, most often children inherit the trees of one of their parents if all of them were born in one climatic zone.

Having studied over eight thousand recorded cases, Meilitsev realized that one and the same tree can take the energy of some individuals and boost the energy of others.

Yvsei Meilitsev is indignant when an asp or poplar growing in the central region of Russia's European part, which take energy, are believed to be harmful. He thinks that it is not right in terms of both essence and meaning. No one consumes useful medicines by the kilogram. Quite often he cites excerpts from Vladimir Dal's Dictionary of the Russian language: "Fever and the tooth ache can be exorcised with the help of aspen bark. Cut a triangle in the bark, rub your gums with it until blood appears while chanting "In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit" and put triangle back to place. If you have a cramp in your leg, place an aspen log at your feet. If you have a headache, place it at your head. For cabbage not to turn too sour, put an aspen log into it."

From time immemorial, Russians used asps for making spoons and well frames. In addition, the roofs and cupolas of churches were covered with aspen plates since asps kill putrefactive bacteria and alleviate inflammations. The trees which absorb energy, or better still, their plates-circles of a trunk 2 to 4 cm high-alleviate pain from contusions and burns as well as pain caused by trauma, operations and oncologic diseases, and cure radiculitis.

However, it is dangerous to use only plates of these trees for healing diseases since they suck off a person's pain inflicting energy and weaken his/her organism to some extent. That is why it is necessary to combine plates of absorbing and energizing trees. However, the best way is to approach Meilitsev

or his pupils with a request to name your own tree and contact it as soon as possible.

Polyarthritis can be cured with the help of energizing trees. It is not a happenstance that oaks have been worshipped since pagan times. Practically everywhere oaks are energizing trees for the majority of the native population. Russian proverbs mention other energizing trees. For instance, "In the pinery you should make merry, in a birch grove- get married". Fir-trees quite often absorb human energy along with aspens and poplars.

Meilitsev's file contains descriptions of thousands of cases pertaining to trees' impact. Some cures look like miracles. I will mention but one case which produced an indelible impression on me. A baby suffering from hydrocephalus, was born in Belarus' Chernobyl disaster zone in 1990. The latest medicines failed to cure him. The baby did not make a single movement for a month and a half. He was brought to Alexander Dovulev, Meilitsev's pupil. The doctor determined that a bird cherry was a baby's absorbing tree. He suggested that a "cap" be made for the baby from bird cherry wood. A miracle happened. Three days later a fontanel could be detected on the baby's vertex. Six months later the baby was absolutely normal.

Meilitsev's discoveries are protected by patents. Together with his pupils, he helps thousands of people find their trees and show how to properly organize contact with them. Considerable sums of money are needed for specialists' training and further research. Russian druids, who are strapped for cash, are looking for sponsors. A host of items can be made using Meilitsev's techniques and sold in drugstores and shops, as well as be used in hospitals and spas.
